

Manifesto for vice president

If I am elected as vice president for the MUMS, my intention will be to improve the experience and quality of membership within the club. There is little opportunity for members to give feedback on how the society is run and so my first proposal will be to set up anonymous online surveys for members which will be sent out twice during each semester; one mid-term and another at the end of the semester. This will give members an opportunity to voice their opinions and help continually improve the society throughout the year. Secondly, in order to build upon the ongoing improvements raised this semester concerning attendance, I would set out a clearer policy regarding absences. I would propose access to documents on the MUMS page regarding absences and the society's guidelines, as well as links to the student union and other organisations that indicate the rights of members. Additionally, I would support the continuation of grade-1athon and the tours into next year.
